

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

December 5, 2008

Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, December 1, 2008:

V.A. Clinic – To allow for the construction of an 83,400-square foot medical office building with associated parking on Lots 1, 2 and 12 of the Seagate Corporate Center. ***The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on December 11, 2008.***

Jack-in-the-box – For the development process of a demolition permit for the removal of the existing drive-thru located at 1702 Mission Avenue prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy for the development of the proposed eating and drinking establishment located at the north west corner of Mission Avenue and Canyon Drive. ***The Commission denied the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on December 11, 2008.***

Parker Residence – To permit the construction of a 116.65 square foot deck attached to the rear first level terrace of an existing single-family residence located at 1633 South Pacific Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on December 11, 2008.***

Historic Preservation Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Oceanside Historic Preservation Advisory Commission (OHPAC) reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Tuesday, December 2, 2008:

Dolphin Hotel – For alterations to the exterior of the Dolphin Hotel, including new paint, repairs to the window frames, and new double-paned windows with screens located at 133 South Coast Highway. ***This item was cancelled from the agenda and withdrawn by applicant's request.***

Mission San Luis Rey Cemetery Expansion – For the construction of four 4,950 square foot mausoleums, one 800 square foot family mausoleum, new perimeter walls, a 590 square foot committal chapel, a 1,500 square foot temporary office, a 3,323 square foot administrative office, and 24,579 new niche and crypts areas located north of Mission Avenue, between Douglas Drive and Academy Road. ***The Commission approved the project by a 4-0 vote and adopted the resolution.***

Mission San Luis Rey Parking Lot Expansion – To permit expansion and improvements to the existing parking lot by constructing 13 additional parking stalls and 4,974 square feet of new paving within the Mission San Luis Rey De Francia property located north of

Mission Avenue, between Douglas Drive and Academy Road. ***The Commission approved the project by a 4-0 vote and adopted the resolution.***

Oceanside Parks and Recreation Youth Basketball

Games will begin on Saturday, December 6th at Melba Bishop and the Beach Recreation Centers. Over 340 youth have registered and there are 45 volunteer coaches.

Successful Drug Control

The North Coastal Prevention Coalition (NCPC) has been selected as the 2008 "Coalition of the Year" by the national Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America (CADCA). CADCA's mission is to strengthen the capacity of community coalitions to create and maintain safe, healthy and drug-free communities, and selects one such coalition annually to recognize efforts put forth by the group to address local substance abuse issues and problems. NCPC, which began as the Oceanside Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition, recently celebrated its fifteenth anniversary of service to the communities of Oceanside, Carlsbad and Vista. The coalition serves as the advisory body to the County-funded Tri-City Prevention Project and Tobacco Control Program managed by Vista Community Clinic; these programs seek to reduce the harm of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana and other drugs in the North Coastal Region. Other programs which brought recognition from CADCA are the annual Anti 4/20 Remix and Sober Celebrations at local schools, now replicated in other cities, and successful efforts to eliminate the sale at events such as Harbor Days of items promoting drug use.
