# **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, December 15, 2008:

<u>Melrose Station</u> – To create 7 commercial lots and construct 49,911 square feet of commercial buildings on an existing 7.4-acre site located on the southeast corner of Melrose Drive and Oceanside Boulevard and situated within the CN District and the Peacock Neighborhood. The Commission denied the project without prejudice by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on December 29, 2008.

<u>Mobile Asphalt Plant</u> – To allow the use of a temporary mobile asphalt plant facility for the operation and processing of used asphalt for redistributing to local municipalities within an existing City property located at the El Corazon site, east of El Camino Real and north of Oceanside Boulevard. The Commission denied the project by a 5-2 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on December 29, 2008.

# **Skate Park Ribbon Cutting Ceremony**

The Martin Luther King Skate Park will open this Saturday, December 20. Dignitaries are asked to arrive at 9:00 a.m. with the ceremony beginning at 9:15 a.m. There will be opportunity drawings and give-aways; any proceeds raised will go towards the fund for the Alex/Foussat Road Skate Park. The Melba Bishop Recreation Skate Park will open sometime in January 2009.
