## **Solar Powered Electric Car**

Parking Enforcement will start a two-week trial evaluation of the *Sunray*, a solar powered electric car from *Cruise Car*, *Inc*. Each morning and evening, one parking officer per shift will use the vehicle in the downtown area to patrol the City parking lots and metered spots as well as respond to other complaints and issues. The vehicle will be stored at the Harbor yard overnight as the vehicle is limited to roads with a speed limit lower than 35 mph. The outcome of the evaluation will determine if Parking Enforcement can use one or more of these in their operation in the future.
