## **Planning Commission Meeting**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, October 8, 2007:

T-Mobile -- For a stand-alone wireless telecommunications facility disguised as a faux pine tree located at 3570 Skyhaven Lane. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on October 18, 2007.

Avocado Parcel Split -- For a two-lot subdivision, to create two approximately 19,000-square foot lots located north of Ivy Road and west of Avocado Road within the Fire Mountain Neighborhood. This item has been continued to the November 19, 2007, Planning Commission meeting.

## **Telestaff**

Information Technologies has recently upgraded the Telestaff software application in use by the Fire Department. This application allows Fire Department personnel to call in or use a web based application called Webstaff to manage their working hours so that the appropriate staffing levels are always maintained. The system can also contact employees to notify them of shift changes or allow them to volunteer for additional shifts, should additional staff be needed. The Telestaff and Webstaff applications provide a total staffing solution that is also used for time sheet validation. The improvements expected to be realized by the upgrade are enhanced system performance, a fifty percent reduction in operating hardware and enhanced functionally for the Webstaff application.
