Planning Commission Meeting

The October 22, 2007, Planning Commission meeting was cancelled. The items listed below will be re-scheduled and re-noticed for the November 5, 2007, Planning Commission meeting. Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, October 22, 2007:

Unyeway Day Care -- For the operation of an adult day care center located at 4065 Oceanside Boulevard, Suites E, F and J. Staff recommends approval.

Miljkovic Parcel Map -- To subdivide a 25,437 square foot lot into two parcels located at 3079 Skyline Drive. Staff recommends approval.
