Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, November 5, 2007:

<u>Unyeway Day Care</u> -- For the operation of an adult day care center located at 4065 Oceanside Boulevard, Suites E, F and J. Staff recommends approval.

<u>Miljkovic Parcel Map</u> -- To subdivide a 25,437 square foot lot into two parcels located at 3079 Skyline Drive. Staff recommends approval.

<u>Shakey's Video Games</u> -- To allow the use of an arcade within an existing restaurant known as Shakey's Pizza located at 4141 Oceanside Boulevard. Staff recommends approval.

<u>First Bank at Palm Tree Plaza</u> -- To allow the construction of a commercial building within an existing shopping center located at the northeast corner of Lake Boulevard and Cannon Road. Staff recommends approval.

<u>Target Center</u> -- To allow construction of a 1,804 square foot drive-thru restaurant, shopping center located at the northwest corner of El Camino Real and Vista Way. Staff recommends approval.

City of Oceanside Martin Luther King, Jr. Civic Award

The Oceanside City Council annually honors a resident of Oceanside or Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, who exemplifies the philosophy and ideals of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and other leaders who have worked to improve community life, develop positive relationships in the community, and enhance the lives of individuals. The award particularly emphasizes contributions and service to the people of Oceanside by a person outside of a work setting and over a long period of time. Nomination forms for the 2008 City of Oceanside Martin Luther King, Jr. Civic Award are now available at City Hall, the Oceanside Public Library and Mission Branch Library, and on the City Web site, the Community Relations Commission page. The 2008 recipient will be announced in January at ceremonies honoring the late Dr. King. The award is not restricted to persons of any particular ethnic or racial group; photos of past recipients are displayed in the community rooms adjacent to the Oceanside Public Library. Oceanview Cemetery Cleanup

The cemetery is located on South Coast Highway, one block south of Oceanside Boulevard. Cleanups are scheduled twice a year on the weekends prior to Memorial Day and Veterans Day. North River Village Mixed-Use Development and San Luis Rey Transit Center Grading

The North River Village Mixed-Use Development and San Luis Rey Transit Center Project was approved by the City Council on September 20, 2006. The project proposes a mixed-use development consisting of approximately 13,684 square feet of commercial uses, 106 residential condominium units, and a bus transit center on a 9.8-acre site located at the southeast corner of the intersection of North River Road and Vandegrift Boulevard. The bus transit center is located in the northern 2.1 acres of the site and the condominiums and commercial uses will occupy 7.7 acres in the southern portion of the site. Grading and erosion control plans for the project were approved on October 26, 2007. Site grading and construction is anticipated to start Monday, November 5, 2007.
