

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

November 9, 2007

Planning Commission Meeting

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, November 5, 2007:

Unyeway Day Care -- For the operation of an adult day care center located at 4065 Oceanside Boulevard, Suites E, F and J. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on November 15, 2007.

Miljkovic Parcel Map -- To subdivide a 25,437 square foot lot into two parcels located at 3079 Skyline Drive. The Commission denied the project by a 5-1 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on November 15, 2007.

Shakey's Video Games -- To allow the use of an arcade within an existing restaurant known as Shakey's Pizza located at 4141 Oceanside Boulevard. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on November 15, 2007.

First Bank at Palm Tree Plaza -- To allow the construction of a commercial building within an existing shopping center located at the northeast corner of Lake Boulevard and Cannon Road. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on November 15, 2007.

Target Center -- To allow construction of a 1,804 square foot drive-thru restaurant, shopping center located at the northwest corner of El Camino Real and Vista Way. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution; call for review/appeal period ends on November 15, 2007.

Day Light Savings Time

Information Technologies successfully completed the transition to Day Light Savings time without incident. Daylight saving time was extended by a month under legislation passed by the Federal government. It began three weeks earlier than usual in March, and was extended by one week to end in November. The significance of this change was that all systems using a clock, including computers, phones, security systems and other electronic devices had to be updated in order to reflect these changes.

Historic Commission Meeting on Oceanside Beach Resort

On October 30, 2007, the Oceanside Historical Preservation Advisory Commission (OHPAC) reviewed and unanimously recommended approval of a request to demo the residential structures located at 109 N. Meyers Street, 106 N. Pacific Street, and 112 A/B Seagaze Drive, and the preservation and relocation of the existing residential structure at 102 N. Pacific Street "Top Gun House" as part of the Oceanside Beach Resort Project.

Genetech Volunteers in Oceanside – November 28, 2007
