COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

November 21, 2007

The Planning Commission took the following actions at their November 19, 2007 meeting:

- 1. <u>Thunderbird Road Subdivision</u> 7-lot residential subdivision located at 683 Thunderbird Drive. Approved 6-0. Appeal period ends Thursday, November 29, 2007.
- 2. <u>Holistic Touch Spa</u> Conditional Use Permit to allow a regulated use (massage establishment). Final approval is required by the City Council. The Planning Commission voted 5-1 to recommend that the CUP be approved for a one-year period. The CUP is tentatively scheduled for a January 9, 2008, City Council hearing.
- 3. <u>El Camino Real Medical Condominiums</u> Tentative Map and Development Plan for a 32,514-square-foot medical building on El Camino Real. Approved 6-0. Appeal period ends Thursday, November 29, 2007.
- 4. <u>Pacific Coast Business Park A, B, and C</u> Approval of 317,591 square feet of industrial and office uses at Pacific Coast Business Park located southwest of College Boulevard and Old Grove Road. Approved 6-0. Appeal period ends Thursday, November 29, 2007.
- 5. <u>Avocado Parcel Split</u> Tentative Map for two-lot subdivision to create two 19,000-square-foot lots located north of Ivy Road and west of Avocado Road. Approved 6-0. Appeal period ends Thursday, November 29, 2007.
