

## **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

**December 27, 2007**

### Development Productivity and Fee Study

The Development Services Department has prepared a Request for Proposals for a Development Productivity and Fee Study. This study was directed by the City Council in December at the time fee increases for development services were approved. The study will be focused on Planning, Engineering, Building and Fire Prevention. It is anticipated that the Economic Development Commission will be involved in phases of the study.

The RFP has been sent to 26 consulting firms. Proposals are due back to the City on February 11, 2008. Once a contract has been awarded, it is anticipated that the consultant's work will take approximately 150 days to complete.

### City/Women's Resource Center Grant Award

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development announced the next round of Continuum of Care grants to support transitional and supportive housing for homeless individuals and families. San Diego County will receive \$5,292,129 for 25 projects, including \$146,702 for the Women's Resource Center in Oceanside. The City of San Diego will receive \$8,807,253 for 22 projects. This is the most the region has ever received in the annual Continuum of Care process; last year's amount was just over \$13 million. Both the City and the County had their applications fully funded with both agencies receiving slightly more than the requested amount because of increases in allowable rents in the Shelter Plus Care Program, a housing assistance program for the chronically homeless.
